1 TECHNOLOGY

Technology is highly encouraged and widely used at WCTA. Personal devices are allowed on campus. Students should be sure to check with their teachers for specific technologies to be used in classes.

2 SUMMER SCHOOL

The only course WCTA students should consider taking during summer school is PE I (Personal Wellness I) . Be sure to take both semesters I & II. All other courses are part of the WCTA curriculum.

3 CLASS SCHEDULE

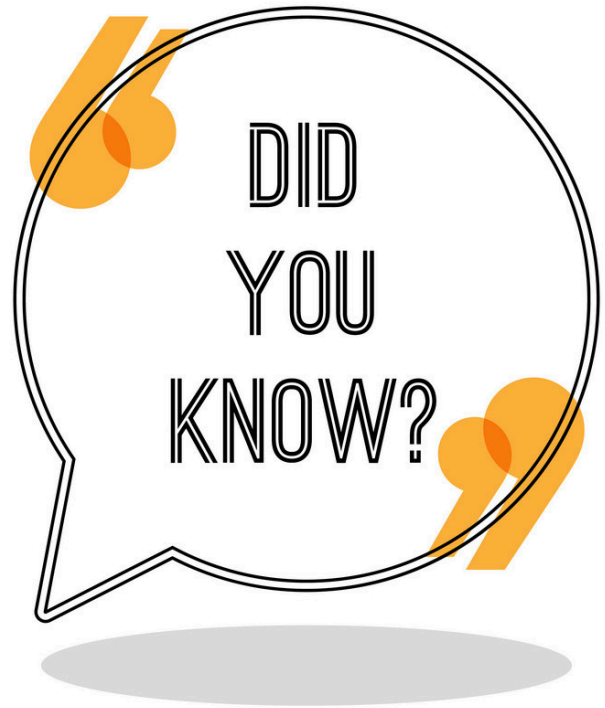
Students will pick up their class schedule at the Wrangler Round-Up in August. If students are unable to attend the Wrangler Round-Up, schedules will be distributed on the first day of school.

4 WRANGLER ROUND-UP

The Wrangler Round-Up is an event held for incoming freshmen and is an opportunity to pick up class schedules, pay program/course fees, request a locker, and learn more about extra-curricular opportunities at WCTA.

5 TRANSPORTATION

CCSD transportation determines who qualifies for a seat on the bus. Contact them directly at 702-799-8100 with questions or concerns.



6 ACTIVITIES/LATE BUS

An activities/late bus is available for students who qualify for CCSD transportation. This bus leaves campus each day at 3:55.

7 SCHEDULE CHANGES

Schedule change requests are not permitted once course registration is complete in May. Students should review the WCTA Schedule Change Policy contained in the Course Catalog located on the school's website.

8 LUNCH

Students are assigned to a lunch period based upon their 5th and 6th period classes. Students are allowed to eat in the cafeteria and the quad. Eating in classrooms and hallways is not permitted.

9 DANCES & ASSEMBLIES

WCTA has several dances, including homecoming and prom, as well as multiple spirit weeks and assemblies throughout the school year.

SPORTS

Competitive sports are not offered at WCTA. Students interested in competitive sports may participate through their zone school; however, transportation to the zone school for practice and games is NOT provided by WCTA.

CLUBS & ACTIVITIES

WCTA offers a wide variety of both curriculum and non-curriculum related clubs, activities, and intramurals. Students will find a list of the many opportunities available to them under the student tab on the school's website.

CTSO

A career and technical student organization (CTSO) is an extracurricular group for students in CTE pathways to further their knowledge and skills by participating in activities, events, and competitions. All students are encouraged to join one of the following CTSOs: DECA, FBLA, FFA, HOSA, and Skills USA.

MAGNET CONTRACT

The CCSD Magnet Contract outlines the expectations for student performance and continuation in a magnet program. Students who violate any of the guidelines pertaining to academics, attendance, behavior, or any combination of the three will be placed on probation. Students who do not meet the conditions of their probation may be dismissed from the program at the end of the school year.

WITHDRAWAL

WCTA becomes a student's home school once enrolled. Withdrawal from WCTA is not permitted during the school year. Should a student wish to withdraw, it must be at the end of the school year.

TUTORING

Math, science, social studies, and English tutoring is available after school Monday, and Wednesday-Friday.

The WCTA library and resource center is a quiet place for students to study, work on homework, use a computer, or complete projects. The library is open to students Monday-Friday, 6:45 am -3:55 pm.
